

Publication agreement

The author or authors permit the Austrian Society for Medieval and Modern Archaeology (ÖGM) to publish and distribute the submitted contribution together with the accompanying figures (pictures, maps, drawings, tables etc.) in printed and/or electronic form.

Data processing agreement (according General Data Protection Regulation GDPR): The author or authors permit the ÖGM, to process and publish his / her / their contact details (name, address, e-mail-address, affiliation) in context with the submitted manuscript in printed and / or digital form as well as online.

Conditions

1. The utilization rights of contributions, which are published by the ÖGM in printed and/or electronic form remain exclusively with the ÖGM. The ÖGM may transfer the rights conceded in this agreement wholly or partly to third parties and grant simple use rights to libraries, archives or open-access portals, as well as other trans-regionally connected long-term archive projects (e.g. Austrian National Library), without the specific permission of the signatory.
2. In the case of manuscripts by more than one author the corresponding author signs the agreement and is re-sponsible for informing his or her co-author or co-authors about the content of the agreement.
3. The author or authors guarantee that the contribution was written by them and does not breach legal rules or the copyright or other rights of third parties (utilization or property rights). The signatory further guarantees that he or she has the necessary permissions to use all material protected by copyright (external text or picture documents) published with the contribution. He or she thus promises to release the ÖGM from all claims by third parties connected to a use for which he or she is responsible.
4. The author or authors promise not to distribute early versions or proofs, either before or after publication of the printed version. Following publication of the BMÖ every author will receive the final version of the contribution in electronic form and is allowed to distribute this specific PDF and to make it available online. The electronic copy (always including the preliminary matter) may only be used and circulated unchanged. This embraces both physical and electronic copies and also the uploading of an electronic version to be read or downloaded in the internet. The necessary prerequisite is that the author or authors possess all necessary rights and take into account the relevant and up-to-date legal circumstances. In exceptional cases, the publishers/editors reserve the right to prohibit the distribution of the electronic document, either permanently or until a period set by the editors has ended. Print copies of the respective volume can be purchased at full price minus an author's discount of 30%. (In the case of monographs (BMÖ supplements / BMÖ Beihefte), authors receive one printed volume, and additional print copies can also be purchased at full price minus an author's discount of 30%.)
5. The renewed use of one's own contribution or of parts thereof is permitted, on condition that the original paper is correctly cited.
